Remembering Jim Brien



It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of **James Arthur Brien** on November 11, 2024. Jim had a keen critical mind, a sensitive godly heart, and a humble demeanor. He was a Biblical Scholar *par excellence* and was reciting his favorite Bible passage in Greek up until his last days (I Peter 1:3-9).

Jim's greatest joy was teaching at the European Bible Institute (Institut Biblique Europeen), north of Paris, from 1976-1998. He met his wife Helen (Dolly) Garlick on a Church Planting team in Lille, France in 1972 and they returned to Michigan to marry in 1974. Jim was from Pontiac and Helen from Bloomfield Hills. They had been married for 50 years.

Jim was the son of Wayne Vernon and Clara Belle (Shelton) Brien. He is survived by his brother Richard Wayne. Jim cared for his sister Judith Ann at her home for a year before her death in 2017. Jim's pride and joy were his precious daughters, Sophie and Julie, and grandsons David (age 9) and Caden (age 5). Sophie resides near Seattle, Washington, with her husband Eric and sons; Julie resides with her husband, Ryan, in Jeffersonville, Indiana.

Jim was very discreet and so was his hidden illness. Following three years of tests and procedures Jim's lung condition was diagnosed as cancer one week before his passing. Surrounded by family, he was called home shortly after midnight on Monday November 11, 2024.

Visitation will be Friday, December 6 from 4–7:00pm at the Lynch & Sons Funeral Home, 1368 N Crooks Rd, Clawson. The memorial service will be on Saturday, December 7, 11:00am at the North Hills Christian Reformed Church, 3150 N Adams Road, in Troy, the Rev. Dr. Randall Engle, officiating. A luncheon reception will follow in the church Fellowship Hall.

Jim's desire for memorial donations in his honor are to The Pontiac Community Foundation dedicated to building a brighter future for Pontiac (pontiaccommunityfoundation.org) or to his beloved church North Hills Christian Reformed Church of Troy (northhillscrc.org).

In the days before his death, Jim memorized I Peter 1 in the original, biblical Koine Greek:

Εύλογητὸς ὁ θεὸς καὶ πατὴρ τοῦ κυρίου ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ, ὁ κατὰ τὸ πολὺ αὐτοῦ ἕλεος ἀναγεννήσας ἡμᾶς εἰς ἐλπίδα ζῶσαν δι' ἀναστάσεως

There are no words to thank you, dear Church Family, for your love and care for me during Jim's last days. You sustained me in body and soul for the 3 weeks Jim was at Troy Hospital and the week following Jim's death soon after midnight on November 11. Delicious meals after 10-hour days at the hospital were a Godsend. With my daughters living out of town, you are indeed my family!

I now invite you to a luncheon reception following the service for Jim on December 7.

Sarah Lawlis sang a benefit recital in our sanctuary on Saturday, October 26. Sarah will travel with the Oakland


