About our Worship Setting for

Epiphany: The four-pointed star of Bethlehem bursts forth over a rainbow of color. The colors of the spectrum reflect the covenant of God that promised His salvation to all people. Notice how the Advent colors of purple and blue are still reminiscent, but are now overshadowed by the light. These waves of color radiate from the light of the star which shines in the darkness, just as Christ's light



came to be a *light unto the Gentiles and the glory of the people of Israel.* The chevron-shapes of color give an unusual energy and glory to the space. Our paraments were designed and fabricated by the late Chris Stoffel Overvoorde, Professor of Art at Calvin University. The gold star communion table cloth and baptismal cap were designed and appliqued by Mrs. Jean Engle, Pastor Engle's mother, and gifted to North Hills in 2014.


