

The Invitation and Indication of the Elements

The Communion

You may come forward to receive the elements from the Pastor; the assisting elder will usher you forward when it is time. If you choose not to receive the elements, cross your arms as a signal.

During the communion, the ensemble will first offer Lamb of God by Allen Pote. The text: O Christ, Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world, have mercy on us. Dona nobis pacem. Give us Your peace. Amen.

The organist will then lead us in devotion during the distribution. When it's time to conclude, we will sing stanza one of *Jesus Loves Me* (Hymnal 709:1).

The Prayer after Communion (prayed together):

Father of all, we give You thanks and praise, that when we were still far off You met us in Your Son and brought us home.

Dying and living, He declared Your love, gave us grace, and opened the gate of glory.

May we who share Christ's body live His risen life; we who drink His cup bring life to others; we whom the Spirit lights give light to the world.

Keep us firm in the hope You have set before us, so we and all Your children shall be free, and the whole earth live to praise Your name. Amen.


